### MANNING

- **Campus Director (full-time)** - Manage overall operations of adolescent shelter and treatment facility. To be considered for this opportunity, a Master's degree in social work, psychology, or counseling is required. Requires professional licensure (LISW or LMHC) and experience in residential treatment. Supervisory experience required.
- **Overnight (part-time/on-call)** – maintains, monitors, and documents resident safety, overnight conditions, and events. Completes bed checks and related assigned duties. Requires HS Diploma. Prior experience working with youth preferred.
- **Relief Resident Counselor (part-time/on-call)** - Provides direct care and supervision of youth in assigned program. Requires Bachelors degree in social science field; or Bachelor's degree in non-social science field; or Associates degree in a social science field plus 1 year child mental health experience; or High School Diploma/GED and 5 years child mental health service experience.
- **Resident Counselor (full-time)** - Provides direct care and supervision of youth in assigned program. Prefer Bachelors degree in social science field; or Bachelor's degree in non-social science field; or Associates degree in social science field plus 1 year child mental health experience; or High School Diploma/GED and 5 years child mental health service experience.
- **Residential Treatment Caseworker (full-time)** - performs casework services of considerable difficulty, directed towards the elimination, reduction or improvement of selected behaviors of children accepted for placement. Acts as team leader to resident counselors assigned to cottage. Requires MSW/MA in social work or related human service field. Will consider BSW/BS/BA in social work or related human service field and two years experience in the delivery of human services. License in social work preferred.
- **Youth Worker (full-time)** – Youth Workers role model responsible behavior and decision making for those youth placed in the shelter. Ensures the safety of youth at all times, function as part of a team that attends to developmental and custodial needs of the residents within the parameters of Quakerdale philosophy. BA/BSW from an accredited college or university in social work or related human service field preferred. Or, AA/AS degree in a related human service field. Or, BA (unrelated field), High School diploma, or GED.

### NEW PROVIDENCE

- **Director of Development (full-time)** - We need an individual to direct an established resource development program and annual fund raising campaign. The position requires a commitment to the Quakerdale mission and a strong desire to share this mission with individuals, corporations, foundations, churches, and organizations for the purpose of raising funds. Supervision/ leadership skills needed overseeing fundraising, grant writing, events and PR coordinating 4 employees in the department. Excellent verbal and written communication skills, demonstrated leadership skills and a desire to work with people of all ages and a variety of socio-economic levels are required. Training and experience in fundraising is preferred.
- **Weekend Offender Resident Counselor (part-time)** – Works in a gender-specific program for teenagers on formal or informal probation to teach teenagers conflict resolution skills, problem solving skills, pro-social skills, interpersonal relationship skills and communication skills to minimize or eliminate psychological barriers to effectively managing symptoms associated with a psychological disorder in an age appropriate manner. Requires a Bachelor's degree in criminal justice, social work, human services, or related field.
