

The Boarding School

The Boarding School is a faith-based, private, Christian residential education school for males. Referrals come from private resources such as parents, clergy and school personnel. These young men attend on-campus school.

The School responds to families who are unable to access resources through the state, lack the funds to receive private help, or desire other alternatives for their student.

The Boarding School offers students :

- A safe living environment
- Adult supervision and guidance
- Academic tutoring and support
- Life skills education
- Spiritual life development
- Recreation activities
- Service learning opportunities
- Assistance in developing healthy relationships

The Promise Academy

The Boarding School is a part of the Promise Academy, located on the New Providence campus, a pastoral setting on 600 acres of rich Iowa farmland.

Education

The School provides a non-traditional, educational community for youth with opportunities such as prep basketball, sustainable agriculture and equine activities. Students live and learn on-campus. The educational approach is a part of a residential education program designed to teach students by:

- Learning core academic requirements, such as, reading, math, and writing skills
- Applying their core academic skills in a hands-on learning environment through real-life activities
- Becoming contributing members of society
