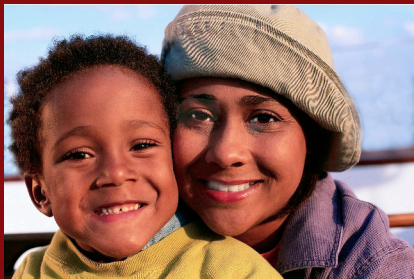
Functional Family Therapy - a short-term, strength-based service with an average of 12 sessions over a 3-4 month period. Services are usually done in the home, school, or office. FFT focuses on specific things the family feels is impacting their child, their family their environment and how to gain skills to better manage those factors.

Location (counties): Marshall, Jasper, Hardin, Story

Children's Mental Health Waiver services, a Medicaid program for children under 18 years old with a mental health diagnosis whose parents choose to use services and individual supports to keep their children in their own home. Services include in-home family therapy. Location (counties): Marshall, Jasper, Hardin, Black Hawk

Counseling services include therapeutic sessions in home or in office for individuals, couples or families.

# Programs & Services

## Onsite Services

- Provide empowerment and education to youth from various backgrounds.
- Offer a safe and comfortable environment and is dedicated to assisting youth as they build the necessary skills they need for healthy living.

Assessment services mental health screening regarding child and family strengths, concerns and service planning recommendations. Includes LPHA assessments for Medicaid's Behavioral Health Intervention Services (Remedial).

Location: All sites

Residential services provide a structured environment with services necessary to contribute to resolution of a child's placement outside of the home. Services are designed to assess the child and families social, emotional and family functioning; develop a treatment plan; and provide skill building with the goal to reunite the family.

Location: Manning (male and female), New Providence(female), Waterloo(female)

Shelter care - a safe, structured, short-term environment for youth during crisis or transition periods. Youth attend area education agency on-site classroom.

Location: Manning

Transitional living services are for older adolescents who need to develop life skills to prepare for self-sufficiency.

Location: New Providence, Waterloo

Day Treatment provides an after-school skill building group setting for juvenile court youth who are at risk of being placed out of the home.

Location: Waterloo (female)

Community Groups are designed to prevent and reduce juvenile crime and to assist youth to live in their home and community. Groups include Aggression Replacement Training, Shoplifting Diversion and Community Service Learning.  
Location: New Providence, Waterloo

Weekend Offender services are for juvenile court females who are on formal/informal probation. Services are designed to reduce crime and recidivism. Services are on site for 6 week intervals from Friday evening until Sunday evening.

Location: New Providence (female)

### **COMMUNITY OUTREACH PROGRAMS**

Mobile Camp - is a free 5-day summer camp that reaches out to children in underserved communities, by promoting positive relationships by introducing children to caring adults in their community.

Equine Program - facilitates relationship and personal development skills through quality time spent with horses.

Sustainable Agriculture Program - equips young people with the skills and confidence to be entrepreneurial leaders, making the earth a better place to live.

Prep-Basketball Program - provides student-athletes positive and safe environment to increase their academic readiness for college as well as further their skills on the court.

Promise Home - offers education and care for youth with a safe home, adult supervision and guidance.

## Flexible Community Services

- All of our caring professionals are community and family focused.
- Flexible community services are driven to provide families, students, children, and individuals support through positive encouragement.
- Although locations are specified, these services are not limited to those specific locations. In 2010, we served people in over 65 counties in Iowa.

Family Team Meetings support and identify what the family hopes to accomplish, set goals and time frames, assess strengths and needs to help accomplish these goals, and match services in the community to help achieve these goals. Location: All sites

Foster Care and Adoption services include recruitment, training, licensing and support of Iowa's foster and adoptive parents, through Iowa Kids Net.

Dream Teams assist transitioning youth to have healthy and meaningful lifelong connections within their community and to help them meet their goals for self-sufficiency.

School -Based services are services and supports, strategies and initiatives to address student needs.

Behavioral Health Intervention services assist individuals in learning appropriate ways to manage behavior and regain self-control. Services educate and support parents in coping with their child's mental illness.
